Namecheap's site builder is a simple template-based, drag-and-drop builder, with nearly 200 templates to choose from. It is available in 45 different languages, is mobile responsive, and e-commerce capable.

What is the Namecheap Hosting Performance Analysis?

 Speed test results— Namecheap offers a 99.9% uptime for most hosting packages. But according to my Namecheap server data, it was up 99.92% of the time over the last year.

Namecheap also offers refunds for one full day of hosting per hour of additional downtime, up to a full month.

 Server response time— The server specs look good, Namecheap uses solid-state drives and a choice of datacenters. The load time was found to be under 500 ms after mid-June, 2018, with an average of 419 ms.

1. Shared Hosting Plans

Here, a number of sites share a single server. They offer three plans, starting at \$15.44 per year or \$2.88 a month.

- Steller- 20 GB of disk space, unmetered bandwidth, access to Namecheap's website builder, and choice of the US or UK datacenter. (You'll have to pay \$1 more for a UK datacenter.)
- Stellar Plus- unmetered SSD-accelerated disk space and unlimited websites.
- Stellar Business- being a top plan for e-commerce sites, this plan offers 50 GB of pure SSD disk space (are also PCI compliant).

2. WordPress Hosting Plans

NameCheap offers three hosting plans for WordPress, starting at under \$4 a month broken down on the basis of site traffic. They also recommend you to increase your plan if you exceed your traffic limit. These plans offer:

3. Reseller Hosting Plans

4. What type of money-back guarantee does Namecheap provide?

Namecheap offers up to a 30-day money-back guarantee for shared and WordPress hosting plans and a 14-day money-back guarantee for reseller and VPS plans. There is no money-back guarantee for dedicated servers.
